

OFFICIAL **Appointments**

The Most Rev. Paul D. Etienne, having carefully assessed the needs of the People of God in the Archdiocese of Seattle, and after careful consultation with the Christian Faithful and the Priest Personnel Board, makes the following pastoral appointments in accord with the 1983 Code of Canon Law effective as noted.

PASTOR

The term of office for Pastor in the Archdiocese of Seattle is six years.

PARISH ADMINISTRATOR

The term of office for Parish Administrator in the Archdiocese of Seattle is generally one to three years.

PARISH PRIEST

The term of office for Parish Priest in the Archdiocese of Seattle is generally one to three years.

PASTORAL COORDINATOR

The term of Pastoral Coordinator in the Archdiocese of Seattle is generally one to three years.

PASTOR: A priest appointed by the Archbishop and delegated as the leader of a particular parish entrusted to him. The pastor's role, expressed in its threefold mission of teaching, governing and sanctifying (CIC, c. 519), empowers the laity for their mission as light and leaven in the world.

PRIEST ADMINISTRATOR: A priest appointed by the Archbishop as a temporary leader of a particular parish with the same responsibilities as a pastor. (CIC, c. 540 §1-3). This office may be held, for example, by seasoned, newly arrived priests or by newly ordained priests who require more experience and formation before being assigned as pastors.

PASTORAL COORDINATOR: A deacon, religious or lay ecclesial minister appointed by the Archbishop under the supervision of a priest moderator and entrusted with the day-to-day leadership of a parish. (CIC, c. 517 §2).

PARISH PRIEST: A priest appointed by the Archbishop to provide priestly ministry in a particular parish in collaboration with the pastor or pastoral coordinator.
