


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## WHAT DOES SUCCESS LOOK LIKE?

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

The word of God "summons us to discernment and it brings light to that process. It guides the Synod, preventing it from becoming a Church convention, a study group or a political gathering, a parliament, but rather a grace-filled event, a process of healing guided by the Spirit."

## PRAYER IN ADVANCE

### Pray in advance.

- Include gatherings in the Prayer of the Faithful at Mass
- Invite the whole parish to pray for the Synodal Process
- Invite individual participants to pray in advance of their session, for at least a few days

### PRAYER AT THE BEGINNING

- Begin with music if possible (a hymn—e.g. Veni Sancte Spiritus; a psalm)
- Time for silence
- A prayerful reading of a Scripture passage (could highlight Church, the Holy Spirit, journey, etc)
- Time for silent reflection on the Scripture, followed by faith-sharing (smaller groups), journaling (larger groups)
- Read a reflection from Pope Francis on the nature of the Synod
- Pray the Adsumus Sancte Spiritus or another prayer

## PRAYER DURING

- Prayer is not just a book-end for the meeting, but the foundation and the setting for the entire meeting
- Allow the silence with which the gathering begins to extend into the gathering,
   allowing pauses to reflect on what has been heard



### PRAYER AT THE END

- Leader invites all to take a few moments of silent reflection on the gathering and what we have heard from each other
- Time for silence
- A prayerful reading of a Scripture passage (could be the same reading you started with; or it could highlight mission, e.g. James 1:27)
- Pray the traditional Prayer to the Holy Spirit together
- Concluding song if possible
- Invitation to exchange a sign of peace

## FACILITATE DIALOGUE & LISTENING

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- Prepare in advance
  - Don't go it alone: note-taking, observer, and facilitator.
  - Review and Share: Relevant Questions (Fundamental, Preparatory, and Online Form)
- Ensure all can participate
  - Consider time limits, if many are attending
  - Redirect the conversation or politely interrupt
- Use available resources to plan an agenda
  - Coordinator's template
  - Facilitator's guide

## TO LISTEN

Being listened to is so close to being loved that most people can't tell the difference.

# FACILITATE DIALOGUE & LISTENING GOALS

- Create safe container for people to be real.
- Listen to understand, not to respond.
- Stimulate trust, bind up wounds, weave new and deeper relationships, and build bridges.
- Honor each person's opportunity to be heard.
- Incorporate moments of silence for reflection.



# SYNTHESIZE & REPORT

#### SYNTHESIZE AND REPORT

- I. Prepare to collect
- 2. Summarize observations
- 3. Submit observations online

### PREPARE TO COLLECT

- Prayerfully work with your listening session team.
- Plan to connect right after the listening session.
- Review the different questions (fundamental, preparatory, and online form.)

# PREPARE TO COLLECT PREPARATORY QUESTIONS REVIEW

**To recall experiences:** What experiences of our local Church does this question call to mind? (Stories)

**To re-read these experiences in greater depth:** What joys did they bring? What difficulties and obstacles have they encountered? What wounds did they reveal? What insights have they elicited?

**To gather the fruits to share:** Where in these experiences does the voice of the Holy Spirit resound? What is the Spirit asking of us? What are the points to be confirmed, the prospects for change, the steps to be taken? Where do we register a consensus? What paths are opening up for our local Church?

**To prayerfully consider answers to questions:** In advance, responding succinctly to respect the goal of max participation.

# PREPARE TO COLLECT ONLINE FORM QUESTIONS REVIEW

- 1. What were common or important themes that emerged from the listening sessions?
- 2. Which particular stories or real-life experiences were shared related to the way our church currently journeys together?
- 3. What dreams, desires, and aspirations for our Church were expressed by participants?
- 4. What challenges or opportunities do these reflections pose as we journey together?
- 5. What did participants share related to the question of "what steps does the Holy Spirit invite us to take in order to grow in our journeying together"?

#### **SUMMARIZE OBSERVATIONS**

- Post-listening meeting with team.
- Prayerfully recollect the session in light of online form.
- Determine responses to online form questions.
- Be accurate. Be succinct.
