

# OFFICIAL **Appointments**

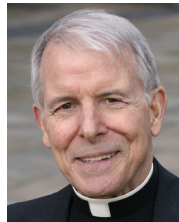
**Rev. Michael E. Radermacher**, appointed Priest Moderator of Holy Rosary Parish in

### **PRIEST MODERATOR:**

A priest appointed by the Archbishop with powers and faculties of a pastor of a parish. His role is to monitor and mentor the pastoral coordinator and parish priest and to act as canonical pastor to the parish community to whom a pastoral coordinator has been appointed.

### **PAROCHIAL VICAR:**

A priest who renders service in pastoral ministry as a co-worker with the pastor, and sharing service in pastoral ministry through common counsel and effort and under his authority (CIC, c. 545 §1-2).

### **CHAPLAIN:**

A priest appointed by the Archbishop to provide pastoral care to a faith community within the Archdiocese (CIC, c. 564).
