

# OFFICIAL APPOINTMENTS

**PAROCHIAL VICAR:** A priest who renders service in pastoral ministry as a co-worker with the pastor and sharing service in pastoral ministry through common counsel and effort and under his authority (CIC, c. 545 §1-2).

**CHAPLAIN:** A priest appointed by the archbishop to provide pastoral care to a faith community within the archdiocese (CIC, c. 564).

**PRIEST IN RESIDENCE:** A priest who is living at a parish providing sacramental support on occasion.
