

## **Native Community Records Access Policy**

- 1. **Access Restrictions:** In consultation with local tribes, and to respect their right to manage access to information about their communities, Native sacramental, school, and cemetery records are closed.
- 2. Requesting Access: Digital copies of these materials have been shared with the respective tribal archives and cultural heritage offices, where they may be accessed in accordance with their policies. Due to the number of tribes involved and varying governance structures, researchers should contact the relevant tribe directly to determine the appropriate office or staff member for records access. The Archives can provide a list of tribal nations represented in our collections.
- 3. **Official Copies:** When an official copy of a sacramental record is required, Archives staff provide notarized certificates after receiving tribal approval.
