Proposed Process

Before gathering for a PFAC discussion around the parish vision, ask each member to answer the questions below. Specifically, each member should pray over the feedback and begin thinking about how to respond to desires expressed during the listening session. These questions will be used as the foundation for the PFAC's vision drafting discussion.

Questions

1. When looking at our previous discussion and the report from our community listening session(s), what stands out as the things the parish family does particularly well? Where does our community see us thriving in the way we encounter, accompany, and live the Gospel?
2. (Question for parish families with schools) What is the school's mission statement and how does that fit into the overall input from the listening sessions? How does the ministry of the school(s) impact the emerging *parish vision* of who we want to become?
3. What major themes, values and specific suggestions did you find in the feedback that should inform our parish **vision**? Who do we hear God calling us to be? Think of specific phrases or charisms.
